- The Year in the Bible class continues with Heather in the Mid-High Room. [The reading plan is available by clicking here](#) and you can join in at any time.

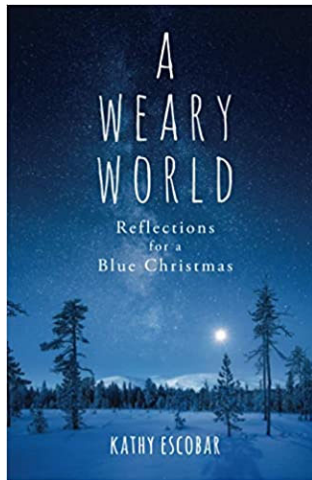
New to the Line-Up on Dec. 5:
